

## The Angus Ski Club – Season 2019/20

Cost of membership is £15 for an Adult, £10 for a Junior (under 18) & £35 for a family.

For season 2019/20 we once again have access to the dry ski slope at RM Condor. Each session runs from 19:00 to 21:00 and the dates are as shown in the following table.

Whilst we will do all we can to satisfy preferred dates, demand by other members, instructor availability and level of ability may result in compromise. However, we will endeavour to ensure that members get at least **4** sessions before and **4** sessions after the Christmas and New Year break.

When you send in your application, also send in a completed Booking Form which should indicate all sessions you wish to attend.

Please note that if you book a session, you must pay for it, even though you do not turn up. The reason for this being that the club has to pay RM Condor for the number of places allocated not the number of members attending on the night. The cost of each 2 hour session is **£13.00** which covers the use of the dry ski-slope, hire of all necessary equipment (boots, skis & poles) plus tuition if required. Please note tuition is only available up to the level of basic parallel turns. All the club's instructors are British Association of Snowsport Instructors (BASI) qualified and are members of the club who undertake this role on a voluntary basis.

Please ensure you wear appropriate clothing which should be warm and waterproof. Gloves are mandatory. Juniors must wear a helmet which is supplied as part of the hire.

**ANGUS SKI CLUB RULES FOR RM CONDOR  
ADAPTED FROM FIS SKI SLOPE RULES**

**THE FOLLOWING RULES MUST BE OBSERVED BY MEMEBRS AT ALL TIMES. FAILURE TO DO SO MAY RESULT IN YOU BEING ASKED TO LEAVE THE SLOPE (\*). PERSITANT FAILURE MAY RESULT IN YOUR CLUB MEMBERSHIP BEING SUSPENDED.**

**1. Respect for other skiers**

You are responsible for your own safety and that of other skiers. Be aware of people around you and take necessary action to avoid skiing dangerously or causing a hazard to yourself or others.

**2. Control of speed and manner of skiing**

Control your direction and speed of travel taking account of other skiers, the condition of the slope and weather conditions.

**3. Choice of path**

Select an appropriate path. If you are skiing behind someone it's your responsibility to ski around them without causing any danger to them.

**4. Overtaking**

You can over-take from either left or right but you must leave enough distance between yourself and other skiers to allow them to manoeuvre properly.

**5. Joining and starting**

Before starting off or pulling out you must look up and down the slope and choose an appropriate moment to execute your manoeuvre, so as not to endanger yourself or other skiers.

**6. Stopping**

Avoid stopping at narrow or enclosed places unless you have to i.e. you're injured. In the case of an injury you must vacate the spot as soon as practicable, to avoid further danger (to yourself or others). You should always stop at the side of the slope.

**7. Ascending and descending**

You must always use the side of the slope to walk up or down, whether wearing skis or not.

**8. Ski Tows**

Always maintain the correct position when using the tow. Do not sit down on the tow. Do not pull the wire up and down. Do not jump the queue.

**9. Taking a Break**

If you wish to have a break and sit down to have something to eat & drink, please do this away from the ski areas, including the access area to the tows. Also ensure that if you take off your skies you place these out of the way e.g. at the edge of the slope.

## **10. Observing the signs**

Pay attention to and follow the signs, markings and notices on the slope.

## **11. Offering assistance**

You are obliged by law to offer help and assistance in the event of any accident.

## **12. Duty to identify yourself**

You are also obliged by law to give your personal details in the event of an accident, whether you caused it, witnessed it or assisted at it.

*(\* Instructor's decision is final)*

### **Procedures for access to RM Condor**

- On entering RM Condor, drive down to the sentry point where there are normally 2 soldiers – one with a gun! Please note headlights should be switched off as you approach.
- Advise the guard that you are going skiing and he should ask you to report to the guard room. This is situated forward and to the left of the sentry point.
- Park your car and enter the guard room.
- What happens next depends on which Marines are on duty, they all do things differently.
- Basically the procedure is that each person swaps their Angus Ski Club membership card for a Condor pass. You also have to ensure you obtain a vehicle pass. Please note that you must provide your vehicle registration number on the information sheet for the Club.
- A Duty Officer from the Club will be present in the Guard Room to check you in. The Duty Officer will remain until 7.15 pm. Once the Duty Officer leaves the Guard Room, you may not be allowed to enter the base. The phone contact number of the Duty Officer will be provided to members attending on each session. If you are going to be late, you should notify the Duty Officer so that they can wait for you to arrive.
- Once you have these, drive back to the sentry position and show your passes.
- You should be allowed on to the base. Drive straight down the main road and you will see the dry ski-slope about 500 yards down on the left hand side. Turn left just before it and park your car.
- Go to the boot room which is located underneath the slope.
- Once in the boot room you exchange your shoes for ski boots and skis. If you have your own ski boots pass one of these over and appropriate skis will be provided. If you require assistance with fastening your boots, ask for help from one of our members.
- Payment should be made to the identified committee member.
- At the end of the session and once you have returned the boots and skis, drive back to the main gate and park your car. Do not exit the base.
- Go to the guard room and swap all Condor passes for your Angus Ski Club membership cards. Also return any vehicle passes.
- Return to your car and drive off the base. You do not have to stop at the sentry point on exit.
- Please observe the speed limit at Condor.
